



ELISABETH CURTIS CENTRE '200 CLUB'

The 200 Club is a monthly lottery issuing up to 200 draw tickets and operated as a Private Society Lottery as defined in the Gambling Act 2005. The purpose of the lottery is to raise funds for Elisabeth Curtis Centre to use towards operational costs. The 200 club is promoted by trustees Victoria Liston and Alister Barnes.

Each single ticket entry to the Draw will cost £5/month for which a Draw Number will be allocated and entered to the monthly draw. 45% of all income each month will be paid out in prizes (1st Prize – 20%, 2nd Prize – 15%, 3rd Prize – 10%), 5% of income each month will be saved towards a 'bumper prize pot' award in December. The remaining 50% of income each month will be allocated to Elisabeth Curtis Centre funds to be used in delivery of the centres operations.

With full membership (200 members) the total annual prize money pot would be £6000. With less members the prize money will be less.

By joining the 200 Club you will be supporting Elisabeth Curtis Centre with essential funds, but will also be in with a chance to win a prize for each month that you are entered to the draw. To enter, please complete the application form, via our website (under the fundraising tab), and you will then be contacted by the promoter to arrange payments. Payments can be made by standing order of £5 each month or an annual upfront payment of £60. Prizes will be paid by bank transfer.

RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. The Elisabeth Curtis Centre 200 Club will be operated as a Private Society Lottery as defined in the Gambling Act 2005. The primary promoter will be Alister Barnes, a trustee of the centre. Decisions concerning changes to the 200 Club policy will be made by the Elisabeth Curtis Centre Management Committee.
2. Where rules or conditions of this 200 Club need to be amended by the promoter then notice will be given to all current members of the 200 Club, at that time, by email.
3. Only members of Elisabeth Curtis Centre may join the 200 Club and, as such, via the application process, those who request to join the 200 club will be required to join Elisabeth Curtis Centre as an Associate Member (no fee). Promoters of the lottery will not be allowed to take part in it.
4. Members must be over 16 years of age.
5. The 200 Club will be limited to 200 draw tickets each month, but one member may purchase more than one draw ticket. All 'initial' applicants will be allocated one draw ticket each (up to the maximum 200) before applications for multiple tickets are processed. When the limit of 200 tickets/month have been sold, any subsequent requests for entry to the Draw will be held in reserve on a waiting list with the first on the list being given first option to enter the Draw should a space become available.
6. The first Draw will commence in January 2023; prospective members must subscribe to the 200 Club in advance and first submit an application form to the promoter and state the number of draw tickets requested for each month. The promoter will process the application

and then either request payment for each ticket, or list the applicant, in order, on a waiting list should there be no available tickets.

7. New members can apply to join the 200 Club at any stage. The promoter will advise if there are spare tickets available and which month membership will commence from.
8. Successful entrants can either make a one-off annual payment of £60/ticket or create a monthly standing order payment of £5/ticket to be paid on 1st of the month.
9. For each purchased draw ticket a Draw Number will be allocated to the member.
10. If payment for a draw ticket has not been received by the 10th calendar day of the month in which the draw is taking place then the associated Draw Number will not be included in that Draw. The promoter reserves the right to reallocate any Draw Number where payment has not been received on time.
11. The monthly Draw will be conducted by 3 people from Elisabeth Curtis Centre, including the promoter, at a suitable time within the last 10 days of the month. The results of each draw will be displayed at the Centre, published on the website and winners will be advised by email.
12. **Prizes:**
 - a. 45% of the monthly income from subscriptions will be disbursed as prizes (1st Prize – 20%, 2nd Prize – 15%, 3rd Prize – 10%), 5% of the income will be reserved for extra prizes in the December Draw. The remaining 50% of income will be transferred to Elisabeth Curtis Centre funds.
 - b. Regardless of how many Draw Numbers are entered each month (up to 200), there will be 3 regular monthly prizes, as detailed in (a) above in the months January – November.
 - c. In the month of December there will be a larger prize pot of money made up of 50% of December subscription income plus the reserved 5% from each previous month (Jan-Nov) to disperse as follows: 1st Prize – 35%, 2nd Prize – 25%, 3rd Prize – 15%, 4th Prize – 10%, 5th Prize – 10%. A 6th Prize of 5% will be drawn to award to the longest subscribed member (not draw number) who has not won any prize in the previous year up to a maximum of 5 years. Where there is more than one member who has been subscribed for an equal amount of time (i.e each member originally subscribed to enter in the same month draw), then their names will be put in to a separate draw with one name being drawn to win the 5% prize.
 - d. Prizes will be paid, only to the person holding the winning Draw Number, by bank transfer.
13. Members may cancel their subscription to the 200 Club at any time by giving one months written notice to the promoter. Any payments made will not be refunded. It will be the responsibility of the member to cancel any relevant standing orders they may have with their bank.
14. If the promoter decides to terminate the 200 Club then all current members at that time will be given at least one months notice by email and a notice will be displayed at the Centre. Any payments that a member may have made up front, for Draws that will not take place post the termination date, by way of an annual payment, will be reimbursed pro rata.
