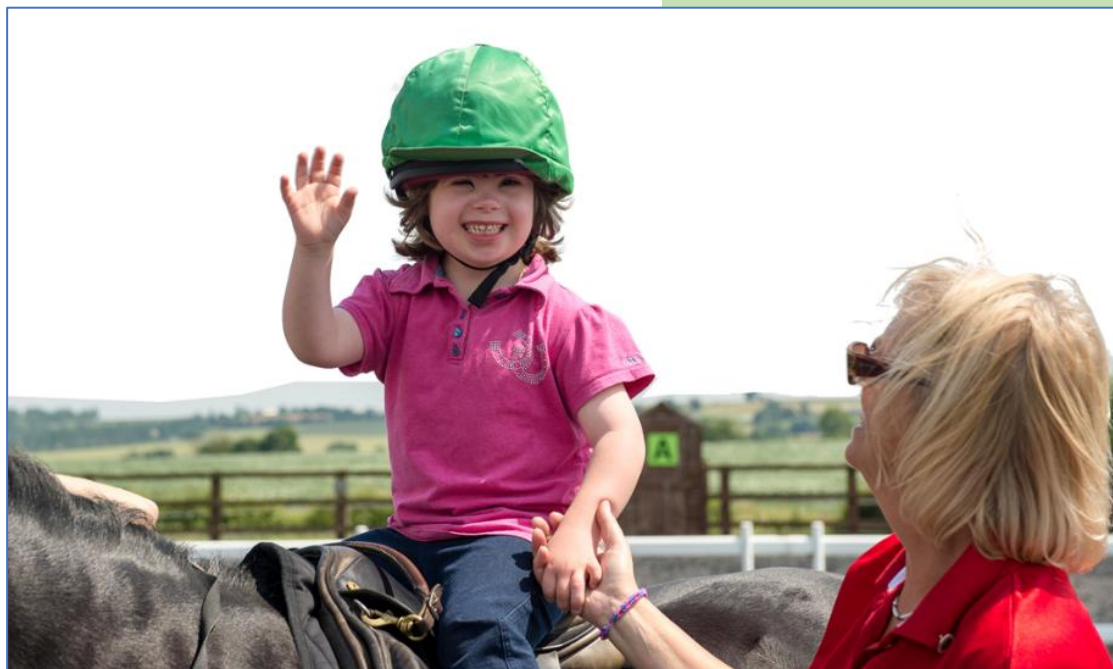

Archie still has lots to learn, but with patience, consistency, and plenty of encouragement, we're confident he will grow into a fantastic addition to our pony team.

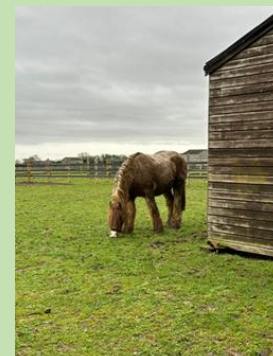
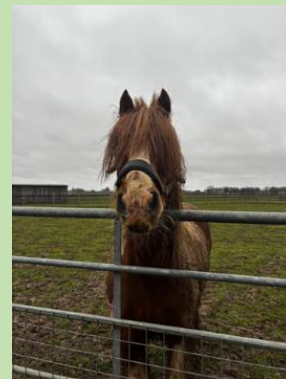
Romeo's Update
